## Scope and Content Note

The Autographed and Inscribed Books collection consists of over 100 books signed, annotated, or inscribed by and/or to persons significant in the history of Christian Science. Persons represented in this collection include contemporaries of Mary Baker Eddy, such as members of her household staff, persons who held positions in The First Church of Christ, Scientist or the Christian Science Publishing Society, those who corresponded with Eddy, and persons who worked in the Christian Science movement post-1910.

The bulk of the collection contains volumes of Eddy's writings, such as *Ü&A} &^Äg äP^äc@*. Many of the books are personal copies bearing signatures of the owner rather than inscriptions to a recipient, and therefore may include notations and markings throughout. For example, the collection includes Hermann S. Hering's copy of the Christian Science Hymnal from when he was the First Reader of The Mother Church (IB0014). Some of the books are signed by multiple persons, documenting students of a Normal or Primary class, as well as the teacher (IB0055 and IB0056, IB0064).

Several books in the collection were signed by the author—for example, copies of Bliss Knapp's *Ü&A} &^Äg äP^äc@* (IB0074 - IB0084), books with titles by Katherine M. Yates (IB0118, IB0120), and books with titles by William P. McKenzie (IB0088 - IB0097). Biographer Lyman P. Powell inscribed his book *T ä^ Áca ^! Áää^ KÜZS^ ÄÜ^ ÄÜ| ;dää* to Margaret Richardson, who painted the portrait of Eddy used in the biography and referred to as "a constant inspiration to the author in preparation of this book" (IB0018). The painting is in the Library's collections (1989.173).

Five books, given on the occasion of Christmas (IB0001, IB0041, IB0104, IB0111, IB0123), show connections between recipient and giver. In an unknown connection, Author J. Allen Boone gifted a copy of his *Letters to Strongheart* to Gilbert C. Carpenter, Jr. in 1939. Strongheart was a German Shepherd canine film star of the 1920s, and Boone was the dog's caretaker for a short time. Boone inscribed the book, "Dear Gilbert, Because you speak our language so fluently, Strongheart and I are particularly happy that you have copies of these letters" (IB0006).

Some books were inscribed with reminiscences of those who used them during a specific event. Clifford P. Smith inscribed copies of *T ä^ &^|lä^ ^~ • ÄY ;ää \* • ÈFì Ì HÈFì Jì* (IB0019), *Ü&A} &^Äg äP^äc@ äÜS^ ÄÜ^ ÄÜ|* (IB0065), and the Holy Bible (IB0098), all used in the close of the Sunday service on December 4, 1910 and at Eddy's funeral service on December 8, 1910. Smith was First Reader of The Mother Church at the time. Carol Hoyt Powers similarly inscribed a copy of *Ü| ^{ •*, from which she read "Mother's

Evening Prayer" during that funeral service. On the same day, Mary Beecher Longyear inscribed a copy of *Ú[ ^{ •* to Eddy in loving sentiment (IB0024).

This collection also includes a copy of *Ú&A } & ^{ a P ^{ a c @* that Laura Lathrop, who taught a class on Christian Science at Riggs House in Washington, D.C., inscribed to Susan B. Anthony (IB0030), who was one of her students. Anthony received the book on March 1, 1887. Thirteen years later, Anthony inscribed this copy to her friend Emily Gross.

Although Eddy may have owned some of these books (IB0031, IB0032, IB0045, IB0047), she did not inscribe any of them. Books with her autographs and inscriptions comprise the Mary Baker Eddy Autographed and Inscribed Books.
