Scope and Content Note

The Mary Baker Eddy sheet music consists 80 handwritten and printed musical arrangements owned by Eddy and present in her home at Chestnut Hill. Items include her poetry set to music, sheet music inscribed to and dedicated to her, and one volume signed by her, titled "Songs of Praise" (SM0050).

The collection has no series and is cataloged at the item level.






