## **Biographical Note**

Mrs. Eddy's Room was originally referred to as "Mother's Room" until 1903, when the Church Manual By-Law "The Title of Mother Changed" (now Article XXII, Section 1) was adopted. This was a furnished accomodation and study/reception room in The First Church of Christ, Scientist, Original Edifice, created solely for Mary Baker Eddy's use. The room was dedicated January 6, 1895, the same day as the Original Edifice. Not in attendance for the dedication, Eddy visited the Original Edifice and spent nights in the room on April 1 and 2, 1895; May 25 and 26, 1895; and January 4 and 1896.

Fundraising for Mrs. Eddy's Room began as the idea of Maurine Campbell, a student of Christian Science who worked at The Christian Science Publishing Society. In October 1890, she started the Young People's Fund, to raise money for a church building. A few days later, she started a children's fund to create a room in the church for Eddy. In April 1891, a letter from Campbell to all Christian Science children was printed in The Christian Science Journal. She asked them, "...will it not be lovely for your offerings to build and furnish Mother's Room?"

Twelve Sunday School children began raising funds. Later referred to as "Busy Bees," they grew in number, as did their efforts, until fundraising ceased on the dedication day, when the room first opened to the public. The room also reflected the children's offerings in its outside mosaic, which originally bore the name "Mother's Room/The Children's Offering." In 1904 it was changed to say "Rev. Mary B. Eddy's Room/The Children's Offering."

The Children's Fund also assisted in furnishing the room with many items, including a bookcase containing Eddy's writings, bound in white Levant. Bookmarks were also gifted for use with the books.

In 1908 the room closed to all visitors at Eddy's request (L01001), following the adoption of the By-Law "Mrs. Eddy's Room," Article XXII, Section 17. Since then the room has remained closed. Over time its contents have been removed, including 28 books and three bookmarks that were transferred to the Archives.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of 25 books and three bookmarks placed in Mrs. Eddy's Room in The First Church of Christ, Scientist, Original Edifice. It is unclear which books were present in the room at the time of dedication; however, all the books in the collection are original to the room.

Some of the books postdate the room's dedication, but all of them predate its closing, including the 1907 edition of Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures (1939.01.15A) and Christian Science versus Pantheism (1939.01.21A), published in 1898. The Bible (1939.01.24), also bound in white Levant, and the 91st edition of Science and Health (1939.01.14) were most likely present at the time of the room's dedication and described in the Journal, January 1895, "elegantly bound in white Levant, with white Morocco and white watered silk fly-leaf, and Oxford India paper, – also a gift of a Scientist"

The collection includes three bookmarks. Two girls from Kansas gave the silk satin ribbon bookmark (1939.01.24B) for use in the Bible, with excerpts from John Greenleaf Whittier's poem "The Meeting". The girls may have been Anna M. Young and her sister.

The collection consists of no series. Books are catalogued at the item level. The collection is arranged by item numbers not assigned in any specific order. Bookmarks are assigned item numbers, indicating the books from which they were found.

Numbering of the items is inconsistent. Although all the books and bookmarks are original to the room, numbering occurred at different times.
